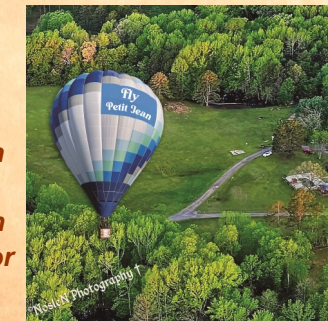

## Arkansas' Original and Most Popular State Park Petit Jean State Park

Petit Jean State Park is an Arkansas classic, a natural and historic treasure that has welcomed travelers for decades. The natural beauty and ancient geology of Petit Jean Mountain



inspired the creation of Arkansas's first state park and, with it, the Arkansas state park system. The park mirrors the mountain's rugged beauty with its rustic-style, native log and stone facilities constructed by the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) beginning in 1933. The CCC built trails, roads, bridges, cabins, and the focal point of the park, historic

Mather Lodge, a 24-room lodge overlooking Cedar Creek Canyon with a restaurant, meeting rooms, and gift shop. The park also features miles of scenic hiking trails, Cedar Falls, and Lake Bailey, where visitors can fish, paddle, or enjoy a peaceful view. With cabins, campsites, and yurts available, Petit Jean is the perfect base for an unforgettable outdoor getaway.

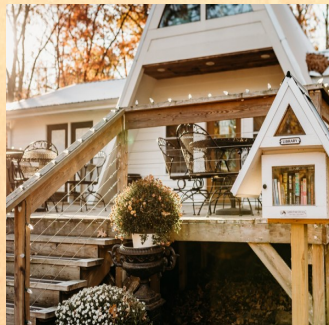

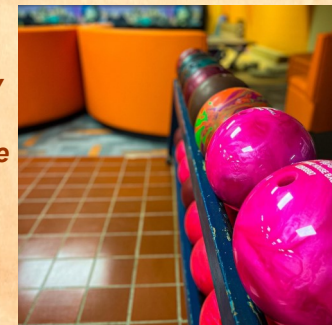
